

Joyce Fournier

Born and raised in Montreal, Joyce Fournier is an internationally collected Landscape and Portrait Artist who lives and works in Toronto, Canada.

Her new series of *Abstracted Landscapes and Horizons* in oil have been inspired by a recent fascination with the spontaneity and gratification of painting from within, rather than working on location or from life, her usual process. Many of the new paintings are conceptual in nature having been created with minimal *'Planning'* as it were. The new direction is a refreshing change and a contrast to Joyce's more formal *Figurative* works for which she is best known.

Classically trained at the Academy of Realist Art in Toronto, Joyce has exhibited in several solo and group shows within Canada and internationally during the past decade. Her Abstracts, Landscapes, Figurative works and Commissioned Portraits are found in private and public collections in Canada, the USA, and Europe.

Joyce's work has been featured on several occasions in the prestigious *American Art Collector* magazine since 2009.
