She started in 1988 with a four year program in visual arts. After the first two years, she specialized ceramics in her third year and displayed her work at exhibitions in this final year. After this, she established her own business and workshop.

Throughout the years, she kept experimenting artistically with processes and materials and developed her own unique techniques. Driven by the desire to renew constantly and to be unrestricted and free, she broadens her horizon in multiple disciplines.
