My way of proceeding when making my art finds its echo in Mark Rothko's writings and in the thinking of the COBRA artists. In his essay "New Training for Future Artists and Art Lovers" (1934) Mark Rothko emphasizes the creative benefits of approaching art like a child might: instinctively. The COBRA artists' working method was also based on spontaneity and experimentation.

I'm pursuing this working method for my current artistic projects: exploring the more and more brutal violence exercised by some viewers towards contemporary art and exploring the impact the Witch Hunt still has on Western Society.

On the top of my artistic canon is Louise Bourgeois followed by Judith Chicago, Niki de Saint Phalle and Annette Messager and then by Asger Jorn.
