

Marc Olthoff's Walk of Life

After graduating as a master of science in electrical engineering, Marc worked at Unilever for 21 years. In 2012 he quit his position as "Technology Director" following his passion to become a fine-art photographer.

Although he had been an enthusiastic photographer since childhood, Marc realised he lacked some of the skills required to produce the fine-art images he envisioned. He went 'back to school' and graduated in 2015 as best of his class from the Fotovakschool in Rotterdam.

Marc's main strength is in his ability to conceive and design creative images that are tantalising with the technical and managerial skills to realise them. He tries to put a story into each image, encouraging viewers to think and wonder about what they are actually seeing and what it means. His technical and engineering background is helpful in realising these images.

Over 60 of Marc's images were awarded in international photography contests. In total they amassed over 120 awards.

Marc has been a Jury member for the New York photography awards and for the European photography awards.
